Single Payer Prohibition v1

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Colorado:

**SECTION 1.** In the constitution of the state of Colorado, **add** section 17 to article XVIII as follows:

## **Section 17. Right to Private Health Insurance.**

- (1) **Definitions.** WITHIN THIS SECTION:
- (a) "SINGLE-PAYER INSURANCE" MEANS UNIVERSAL HEALTH INSURANCE ADMINISTERED BY THE STATE OF COLORADO THAT EVERY RESIDENT OF THE STATE IS REQUIRED TO HOLD.
- (b) "Universal health insurance" means a public system that provides the same public health insurance to all residents of the state.

## (2) Single-payer insurance prohibited.

- (a) THE STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENTS SHALL NOT BAN ACCESS TO PRIVATE HEALTH INSURANCE, NOR SHALL THE STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENTS REQUIRE RESIDENTS TO CONTRIBUTE TO OR PARTICIPATE IN A SINGLE-PAYER INSURANCE SYSTEM.
- (b) Nothing in this section shall prohibit the state from administering healthcare provided to individuals who are qualified to receive benefits through Medicaid or any other similar federally-funded program.
