Be it enacted by the People of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, ~~title 6,~~ **add** article 7.2 [to title 6](#) as follows:

Article 7.2. Consumer right to energy choice.

6-7.2-101. Declaration.

~~(1)~~ THE PEOPLE OF COLORADO HEREBY FIND AND DECLARE THAT:

(a) GOVERNMENT REGULATIONS RESTRICTING OR BANNING COMMON-USE PRODUCTS AND SERVICES SUCH AS GAS-POWERED VEHICLES, STOVES, HEATERS, AND LAWNMOWERS, AS WELL AS PROPANE-FUELED PRODUCTS, CREATES SEVERE FINANCIAL, SAFETY, AND PRACTICAL BURDENS FOR WORKING CITIZENS; AND

(b) ACCESS TO ENERGY TO POWER AND HEAT HOMES, COOK, AND OPERATE EQUIPMENT IS A MATTER OF STATEWIDE CONCERN.

~~6.7.2-102~~ **6-7.2-102. Restriction on access to energy prohibited.**

(1) STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT SHALL NOT BAN OR RESTRICT PRODUCTS OR ~~SERVICES~~ [SERVICE CONNECTIONS](#) POWERED BY AN ENERGY SUPPLY IN COMMON USE BASED ON THE ENERGY SOURCE THAT POWERS OR FUELS THAT PRODUCT OR SERVICE [EXCEPT FOR HEALTH OR SAFETY RESTRICTIONS OF THE INTERNATIONAL BUILDING CODE, OR ITS SUCCESSOR.](#)
