*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Colorado:* 

**SECTION 1.** In the constitution of the state of Colorado, **add** Section 17 to Article XVIII as follows:

## Section 17. Energy choice.

- (1) **Definitions**. AS USED IN THIS SECTION:
- (a) "ENERGY" MEANS THE METHOD OF GENERATION OR THE FUEL SOURCE.
- (b) "CONSUMER" MEANS ANY PERSON WHO IS THE BUYER OR USER OF A PRODUCT.
- (2) **Energy choice.** Consumers have the right to choose from commonly used energy sources and to purchase and use products and services that are powered by a commonly used energy supply, such as solar, wind, electricity, natural gas, and propane, and this energy choice includes but is not limited to the following applications:
- (a) CURRENT AND FUTURE ENERGY SERVICE CONNECTIONS IN A HOME OR BUSINESS;
- (b) Purchase and use of vehicles, agricultural equipment, or small power and lawn equipment; and
- (c) PURCHASE AND USE OF INDOOR AND OUTDOOR COOKING APPLIANCES AND GRILLS, HEATING AND COOLING SYSTEMS, AND HOME APPLIANCES.
- (3) **Public safety exception.** This section does not apply to health or safety restrictions of the International Building Code, or its successor, or in case of a public safety emergency, such as fire or natural disaster.

## **SECTION 2. Effective date.**

This act shall take effect upon proclamation by the Governor announcing the approval, by the registered electors of the state, of the proposed initiative.
