

Ballot Title Setting Board

Proposed Initiative 2007-2008 #37¹

The title as designated and fixed by the Board is as follows:

An amendment to the Colorado Revised Statutes concerning the deauthorization of the water resources and power development authority, and, in connection therewith, specifying the mechanism by which the powers, duties, functions, records, personnel, property, and unexpended balances of appropriations, allocations, or other funds of the water resources and power development authority will be transferred to any other designated governmental department.

The ballot title and submission clause as designated and fixed by the Board is as follows:

Shall there be an amendment to the Colorado Revised Statutes concerning the deauthorization of the water resources and power development authority, and, in connection therewith, specifying the mechanism by which the powers, duties, functions, records, personnel, property, and unexpended balances of appropriations, allocations, or other funds of the water resources and power development authority will be transferred to any other designated governmental department?
