**NOTICE
OF
APPLICATION FOR DETERMINATION OF ABANDONMENT
OF THE TOWN OF CHIHUAHUA
IN SUMMIT COUNTY, COLORADO**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that, pursuant to section 31-3-201, C.R.S., the county attorney of the County of Summit, State of Colorado, made application to the Secretary of State for a determination that the Summit County town of Chihuahua is abandoned. The application alleges as its grounds that the town failed, for a period of longer than five years immediately before the filing of the application, to hold any regular or special election, elect officers, or maintain the functions of any town government. The application also alleges that there are no current residences in or residents of the town.

A hearing is scheduled for August 22, 2013, beginning at 11:00 A.M. in the Blue Spruce Room, Office of the Secretary of State, 1700 Broadway, Denver, Colorado, 80290. At the hearing, evidence and testimony will be taken from any interested person. The public is invited to attend.

In accordance with part 2 of article 3 of title 31 Colorado Revised Statutes, after hearing the application the Secretary of State will determine whether or not the town of Chihuahua is abandoned.
