Yesterday, counsel for Complainant filed an Unopposed Motion to Stay the proceedings. The Motion to Stay asserts that the parties have executed a tentative settlement agreement on June 11 to resolve the allegations in the Division’s complaint and are in the process of submitting that agreement to the Deputy Secretary of State for approval. I find that there is “good cause” for a continuance of thirty days, as allowed by § 1-45-111.7(6)(a), C.R.S., to finalize settlement of the case. The Motion to Stay is GRANTED.
