On June 3, 2013, the proponents of the petition to recall Senator John Morse submitted 16,198 petition signatures to the Secretary of State. To be deemed sufficient, the petition must contain at least 7,178 valid signatures.¹

Petition verification summary:

Number of valid signatures required	7,178

The petition contains more than enough valid signatures and is therefore sufficient. Within 15 days from this date, any eligible elector who objects to this determination may submit a written, notarized protest to the Secretary of State.²

A record of all signatures accepted and rejected—including reasons for each rejection—is on file with the Secretary of State.
