



STATEMENT OF SUFFICIENCY


On February 25, 2020, Dan Himelspace, Democratic candidate for Colorado House of Representatives, District 6, submitted 1,680 petition signatures to the Secretary of State. The candidate seeks nomination by petition to the June 30, 2020 primary election ballot. Under Colorado law, Mr. Himelspace's petition must contain at least 1,000 valid signatures.¹

Petition Verification Summary:

Number of qualified signatures submitted	1,680
Number of entries rejected	192
Number of entries accepted	1,488
Number of valid signatures required	1,000

The Secretary of State has determined that Mr. Himelspace submitted a sufficient number of valid signatures to qualify for placement on the 2020 Democratic Party primary election ballot. A record of all accepted and rejected signatures is on file at the Secretary of State's office and will be maintained as a public record.

¹ Under section 1-4-801(2)(b), C.R.S., a major party general assembly candidate petition requires "the lesser of one thousand signers or signers equal to thirty percent of the votes cast in the district at the contested or uncontested primary election for the political party's candidate for the office for which the petition is being circulated . . ."
