## STATEMENT OF SUFFICIENCY

On March 2, 2020, Lindsey N. Daugherty, Democratic candidate for Colorado House of Representatives, District 29, submitted 1,540 petition signatures to the Secretary of State. The candidate seeks nomination by petition to the June 30, 2020 primary election ballot. Under Colorado law, Ms. Daugherty's petition must contain at least 1,000 valid signatures.<sup>1</sup>
