STATEMENT OF INSUFFICIENCY

April 21, 2020

On March 17, 2020, Maya Wheeler, Democratic candidate for Colorado House of Representatives, District 41, submitted 1,142 petition signatures to the Elections Division of the Secretary of State. The candidate seeks nomination by petition to the June 30, 2020 primary election ballot. Under Colorado law, Ms. Wheeler's petition must contain at least 1,000 valid signatures.¹

Petition Verification Summary:

Number of qualified signatures submitted	1,142
Number of entries rejected	242
Number of entries accepted	900
Number of valid signatures required	1,000

The Elections Division of the Secretary of State has determined that Ms. Wheeler submitted an insufficient number of valid signatures to qualify for placement on the 2020 Democratic Party primary election ballot. A record of all accepted and rejected signatures is on file at the Secretary of State's office and will be maintained as a public record.

¹ Under section 1-4-801(2)(b), C.R.S., a major party general assembly candidate petition requires "the lesser of one thousand signers or signers equal to thirty percent of the votes cast in the district at the contested or uncontested primary election for the political party's candidate for the office for which the petition is being circulated . . ."
