STATEMENT OF SUFFICIENCY

August 10, 2020

On July 27, 2020, Ken Mihalik, a nonpartisan candidate for Regional Transportation District Board of Directors, District G, submitted 350 petition signatures to the Elections Division of the Secretary of State's office. The candidate seeks nomination by petition to the November 3, 2020, general election ballot. Under Colorado law, Mr. Mihalik's petition must contain at least 250 valid signatures.¹

The Elections Division of the Secretary of State's office has determined that Mr. Mihalik submitted a sufficient number of valid signatures to qualify for placement on the 2020 general election ballot.
