STATEMENT OF SUFFICIENCY

August 14, 2020

On July 24, 2020, Marcus Allen Murphy, Unaffiliated candidate for United States House of Representatives, District 5, submitted 2,884 petition signatures to the Elections Division of the Secretary of State's office. The candidate seeks nomination by petition to the November 3, 2020 general election ballot. Under Colorado law, Mr. Murphy's petition must contain at least 1,500 valid signatures.¹

Petition Verification Summary:

The Elections Division of the Secretary of State's office has determined that Mr. Murphy submitted a sufficient number of valid signatures to qualify for placement on the 2020 general election ballot. A record of all accepted and rejected signatures is on file at the Secretary of State's office and will be maintained as a public record.

¹ Under section 1-4-802 (1)(c)(III), C.R.S., an unaffiliated congressional candidate petition requires "the lesser of one thousand five hundred signers or signers equal to two and one-half percent of the votes cast in the congressional district in the most recent general election . . ."
