STATEMENT OF INSUFFICIENCY

August 2, 2022

On July 14, 2022, Lori Boydston, an unaffiliated candidate for Colorado State Senate, District 4, submitted 1,204 petition signatures to the Elections Division of the Secretary of State's office. The candidate seeks nomination by petition to the November 8, 2022, general election ballot. Under Colorado law, Ms. Boydston's petition must contain at least 1,000 valid signatures.¹
