STATEMENT OF SUFFICIENCY

2021-2022 Proposed Initiative #96 "Concerning Liquor Licenses"

August 26, 2022

On August 4, 2022, the proponents and designated representatives of 2021-2022 Proposed Initiative #96 ("Concerning Liquor Licenses") submitted 225,400 petition signatures to the Elections Division of the Secretary of State's office. After reviewing a five-percent random sample of the submitted signatures, the Elections Division of the Secretary of State's office projected the number of valid signatures to be greater than 110 percent of the total number of signatures required for placement on the ballot.

Random sample verification summary:

Total number of entries accepted (valid) from the random sample	7,490
Total number of entries rejected (invalid) from the random sample	3,780
Number of projected valid signatures from the random sample	149,799
Total number of signatures required for placement on ballot	124,632
Projected percentage of required valid signatures	120.19%

Because the random sample verification established that the projected number of valid signatures totals 120.19 percent of the amount required for placement on the ballot, 2021-2022 Proposed Initiative #96 is sufficient and will be certified to the 2022 general election ballot.
