STATEMENT OF SUFFICIENCY

February 28, 2024

On February 16, 2024, Lindsey Daugherty, Democratic candidate for Colorado State Senate, District 19, submitted 1,661 petition signatures to the Elections Division of the Secretary of State's office. The candidate seeks nomination by petition to the June 25, 2024 primary election ballot. Under Colorado law, Ms. Daugherty's petition must contain at least 1,000 valid signatures.¹

Petition Verification Summary:

The Elections Division of the Secretary of State's office has determined that Ms. Daugherty submitted a sufficient number of valid signatures to qualify for placement on the 2024 Democratic Party primary election ballot. A record of all accepted and rejected signatures is on file at the Secretary of State's office and will be maintained as a public record.

¹ Under section 1-4-801(2)(b), C.R.S., a major party general assembly candidate petition requires "the lesser of one thousand signers or signers equal to thirty percent of the votes cast in the district at the contested or uncontested primary election for the political party's candidate for the office for which the petition is being circulated . . ."
