Election Order 2024-02

Re: Recount of State House Representative District 58 Republican Primary

Date: July 15, 2024

Operative Facts

On Tuesday, June 25, 2024, a primary election was held to determine who would represent the Republican Party as State House Representative for District 58. Election results for this race were audited in accordance with section 1-7-515 C.R.S. and that audit confirmed the results of the election. District 58, consisting of Delta, Dolores, Gunnison, Hinsdale, Montezuma, Montrose, Ouray, and San Miguel counties, canvassed its results in accordance with Colorado law. All canvass results were submitted on July 11 through July 12.

At the conclusion of the tabulation of all eight counties making up District 58, Larry Don Suckla received 50.01% (6,488 votes) and J. Mark Roeber recevied 49.99% (6,485 votes). Pursuant to Colorado law, the percentage of vote totals between the candidates requires the Secretary of State to order a recount. Section 1-10.5-101, C.R.S.

Order

- 1. As required by section 1-10.5-102 (1), C.R.S. I hereby order a recount of the House District 58 Republican Primary race.
- 2. The recount must be completed no later than Friday, July 26, 2024, as required by 1-10.5-102(2), C.R.S.
- 3. Within 24 hours of the issuance of this Election Order, each county shall provide to the Election Division of the Secretary of State's Office with the dates and times the county expects to begin, conduct, and complete its recount. Each county clerk must immediately notify the Election Division in writing if its recount schedule changes for any reason.
