Subject: revised campaign finance rules

My name is William S. Killgore. I am an insurance broker in Grand Junction, CO and I am a member of the Colorado State Association of Health Underwriters (CSAHU) and I am their PAC Chair. My responsibilities are to help raise funds for our Legislative Committee and Lobbyist. Those two entities provide small funds to legislators for campaign activities.

In 2009, during a move of our office to a new location, I was without my computer system to provide a campaign finance report to the SOS. I missed the date by 15 days and was fined \$750.00. I appealed the ruling, but was declined. This fine was very onerous to our small organization not to mention the strict adherence to very tight rules for exclusion of a fine by the SOS. A rewrite of the rules to a more common sense approach would be a refreshing change to the current political system.
