I like the concept of trying to be more specific on residence in light of same day registration - I have the following questions:

Under A questions 1-6 seem germane, but it is unclear as to use - should the citizen respond positively to any one question, more than one? what is the benchmark. On Question 1 it is my understanding that the Military can select any State for income tax purposes are they then required to use that State for voting purposes? Questions 4 seems unrelated and question 5 might not apply to retired individuals. Question 6 could a vacation home qualify for a residence?

Under B (1) seems like a member of the military could consider Colorado Home for the present, but not intend to make Colorado home after military service.

Under B(2) a student might consider Colorado Home for the 4 years of college but not intend to make Colorado home after graduation.
