I question the need for the logbook. I believe it should be sufficient for the notary to ask for photo ID and either note the number, such as a Colorado drivers license, or better, make a copy of the ID. And keep a copy of the document – at least the signature page.

The logbook takes time.

I appreciate the rule that exempts attorneys from the log book requirement and would oppose any attempts to change that.

I would like to know how often the need for the log book – as opposed to less bothersome measures - has been demonstrated.
