Subject: Comments to help shape Colorado's Notary Program Rules

I have a couple of comments.

2.1.2 - The last sentence is confusing because the first part is referring to a new applicant and the last is referring to someone who has committed misconduct. I am unsure if the last sentence means the person has lost their ability to notarize and must now reapply as a new applicant. Also, I would place the second sentence at the end of the paragraph.

2.2.1 – I suggest the following: “A notary may electronically notarize a document only after submitting a request to the Secretary of State on the approved form and approval has been received. A new applicant may file the intent to electronically notarize at the time of application and may electronically notarize when he or she has been commissioned and approved.”
