To whom it may concern:

I work for a small engineering and surveying company in Estes Park and have been a Notary Public for the State of Colorado for nearly 20 years. I was very disappointed to find out that the expiration date has to be part of the notary stamp requiring that every notary public has to purchase a new stamp every 4 years. All our document templates that include a notary signature block already have a line where I can fill out the date of the expiration of my commission.

Please just require that the commission expiration date be included somewhere in conjunction with the signature and stamp of the notary, but NOT on the stamp itself.
