Recognizing that this would likely require a change in law, in Colorado the rules/laws should be to preclude any campaign contributions from other than residents of the district in which a candidate is running, e.g.

- a county level candidate (e.g. commissioner, sheriff, clerk, assessor, etc.) should only be able to receive campaign contributions from within the county
- a candidate for the legislature should only be able to receive campaign contributions from residents of the respective state House or state Senate district

We are tired of having millions of dollars pour in from New York and California in attempts to throw the local elections, or even from having wealthy residents of Boulder or Denver attempt to throw elections in Western Slope elections.
