Rulemaking; Suggestions for improvements

Please consider amending the rule for small rural county's required to make a campaign finance reports in the current manner.

If they receive or have on hand no more than \$1000. dollars received within a two year time period provide or allow for them to be exempt from current reporting requirements and provide that they report to The Secretary of State either annually or biannually with a small service or application fee.

Small rural counties are not close in comparison by resource, population and funding as to the larger and more fiscal producing counties, entities and individuals.

Small counties historically do not solicit or receive funds or donations in large sums. There are many rural counties where political parties make no attempt to report and register with the Secretary of State.

Further provide for penalty forgiveness from rural counties that do indeed make an effort to conform to the law and report activity. Crowley County Democratic Central Committee is a good example.
