Subject: Comments regarding Bingo rules

I would appreciate clarification on Rule 4.1.6 (d), page 17; perhaps add verbiage indicating that the payouts must be made from a bank separate from the sales proceeds. It is confusing as it is currently worded. Of course we use the sales proceeds to pay prizes, but it's PRIOR sales proceeds, not TODAY'S. That is what I assume the rule means.

Under 5.2.4 (Seal Pull Tab Operations) and 5.2.5 (b) on page 21, it calls for a record of players' addresses "to contact them if they are not present when the winning combinations are revealed." Does this mean we are supposed to write them a letter, rather than contact them by telephone? It seems rather outdated to require addresses rather than a phone number or e-mail address.

There is a typo on page 22, in section 5.3.2, on line 2; there is a random "t" between the words "whether" and "all."

There is another typo on page 26, in section 6.3.2 (b) (1); the word "Report" should not be capitalized.

On page 36, I find the entire 9.2 Progressive Prizes section duplicative. 9.2.1 duplicates 3.2.3 (d); 9.2.2 duplicates 5.4.6 (a); and 9.2.3 duplicates 8.4.6 (b).

Also on page 36, under 9.3.3, is there any guidance as to how many "pull tab tickets may be exchanged for an equivalent amount in new tickets of the same deal and serial number"? In my opinion, there should be a limit, such as "up to 100 tickets" (or whatever ceiling you determine appropriate).

Under 13.2.1 on page 43, I would suggest rewording this sentence to read, "A licensed supplier or manufacturer may sell supplies and equipment only to licensees holding a current, valid license." The phrase "licensed licensees" is... well... not good.

Lastly, in section 15.3.2 (g), I am assuming it means that WORKERS may not reserve seats for players. Could you add that clarification? Occasionally players save seats for each other, and if that is what is prohibited, we need to know that.
