Delta County would like to provide feedback for Rule 7.17. During even year elections Delta County has the possibility of 4-5 Elections very close together.

Depending on when the election is determined we have the Presidential Primary in March, Municipal Elections the first week of April, Special District Elections first park of May, and then Primary Elections in June.

Scanning and attaching ballot signatures with this timeframe will be impossible for us to comply with as we manually must scan individual envelopes and attach them. We would prefer to see "Or before the first day to conduct signature verification at the next county or municipal mail ballot election" removed or expand the waiver process to include a waiver for counties that cannot meet these timeframe requirements.
