Also other commenters have already pointed out that many notaries are experienced and don't need full training. I believe the SOS office should not try to provide nor regulate the training classes. It should be like the driver's exams. The SOS office should print a study booklet, much like the DMV provides about the written test traffic rules. Then the potential motorists use parents, private driving schools, as they need to get ready for the test. This also serves an important segregation between the SOS office being the examiner, but not both the trainer and examiner.
