We need to ensure an acceptable government document for citizen voting in Colorado. The current mail-in voting system is highly flawed and encourages my votes to be dis-enfranchised by non-citizen voting. Mail-in voting also compromises the sanctity of a private voting area. Voters can be coerced to cast a ballot a certain way based on pressure from a spouse, roommate, employer, etc. Mail-in ballots can be picked-up and altered by persons other than the voter. Driver license registration encourages non-citizens to register to vote in US elections due to lax birthright citizenship IDs. A secure picture ID with guaranteed citizenship status should be required for casting an in-person ballot.
