Mr. Williams.

Thank you for the invitation to comment on the Office of the Colorado Secretary of State Election Rules, 8 CCR 1505-1 dated June 15, 2018. I notice that there is no actual hearing scheduled. I am sure that someone so attentive to a "failure to act" as yourself would not deliberately omit the actual hearing(s) on 55 pages of far-reaching regulatory changes. Please let us know where and when the public hearings are to take place.

After a preliminary reading, what jumps out at me is all the details about Ranked Choice Voting.

I remember learning in Jr. High that "In American law, anything that was not forbidden is permitted. Under the Code Napoleon [in the time depicted in *Les Miserables*] anything not specifically permitted was forbidden." May I suggest, instead of trying to micromanage the efforts of the counties and municipalities searching for better voting protocols, take note of Nobel-Prize-winner Kenneth J. Arrow's proof that a perfect democratic voting system is impossible. Your office should simply allow the people of each jurisdiction within Colorado to seek its own best way of implementing:

All elections shall be free and open; and no power, civil or military, shall at any time interfere to prevent the free exercise of the right of suffrage.

(Colo. Const. Art. II, Sect. 5)
