To Whom it May Concern:

Thank you for the opportunity to provide feedback on the charitable registration requirements in Colorado! My comments center on the requirement for an authorized representative in the State of Colorado be listed on our application. This requirement only exists in the State of Michigan along with the State of Colorado and adds no value to our registration. Being a higher education institution, we have relied on the use of alumni to act as “authorized representatives” in Colorado and Michigan. However, these individuals have no connection with the charitable solicitation efforts of our University. Rather these individuals allow us to meet the requirements of listing an “authorized representative” instead of having to pay a third party to act as this representative who still maintains little connection with the charitable solicitation efforts of the University. Please consider striking this requirement from the revised regulations for charitable organization registration. Thank you for considering my feedback!
