Hello,

Below are my comments, on behalf of Jefferson County, for the most recently proposed rules.

1.1.26 “Electronic Transmission” means:

- Are we no longer sending electronic ballots for Disaster/Emergency situations?

7.5.3 – Logging disability ballots

- What is the purpose for logging to this detail (each application, name of voter, date packet received, initials of judge that received it)? Will there be a flag in SCORE to track these (to be potentially confidential and deleted afterward), an approved form, etc...?

7.5.5 – Boxes open for ballots

- Which mailing date; UOCAVA or standard? (Specified for the waiver language, below)

7.5.14 – Logging Jailed electors

- Must log number of ballots delivered/received from each facility + provide to SOS. Is there any guidance on how to do this through/with SCORE info? Can a flag for a voter be included in development, in addition to the jail address flag?

7.10 – ADA Surveys of boxes

- We believe the language can be cleaned up for this rule to better reflect that the presidential primary survey is currently due in the year before the election takes place.

17.1.2 – Required to provide mail ballot or replacement, by calling office, if SCORE goes down.

- How would we verify a voter if SCORE is down?
