I would like to bring up the issue of the redundancy of having a notary seal (all embossers are now expired) with an expiration date and then also having to hand write our notary expiration on the notary block. This is redundant and adds more bulk to the existing notary blocks. It also leaves opportunity for error. On several occasions, I have made the mistake of writing the current year, or even full current date on that handwritten expiration line and having to recreate the document.

Removing the requirement to have the redundant handwritten expiration line would be helpful and prevent errors in the notary block. Thank you for considering this.
